

LESSON PLAN: USING PREPOSITIONS

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Level: Intermediate

Total Time: 50 minutes

Topic: Correct Usage of Prepositions	Class: Intermediate Level	Date: 9 th January, 2015
Objectives: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The student will be able to understand the correct usage of basic prepositions of place. The student will be able to apply the correct usage of prepositions of place. 		
Materials: Pictures, bingo game cards and worksheets related to the current instructional topic, Power point Presentation for Bingo game.		
CCQs (Concept Check Questions): What are prepositions of place? Give some Examples. Why is it important to use the correct preposition of place?		
Time	Activities	Sub-skills
10 minutes	Warm Up: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The teacher activates the students by giving them a paper with a drawing on it. All the papers will have the same drawing. (Index A) The teacher then asks one of the students to come up on the board and try to make a drawing which is on the papers of the other students by following the instructions given to her from the other class members. The students will guide her to draw by giving her the directions using the prepositions of place. 	Speaking and listening.
10 minutes	Fill in the gap: The teacher first introduces new prepositions to the students and how they are used.	Listening.
15 minutes	Controlled Activity: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The teacher gives each student a Bingo game card and explains them how it is played. (Index B) The teacher then reads out different sentences with a blank space to add in the preposition. (Index C) The students give their answers. If the correct answer is on their bingo game card they shade, and the game moves on. The first student to get a either a complete row or column shaded must call out Bingo. The teacher checks if all the answers being shaded are correct or not. 	Listening and writing.

10 minutes	<p>Free Practice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The teacher asks the students to form a group of three or four, gives them a worksheet having a crossword related to prepositions of place and asks them to fill the crossword with the correct preposition by using the given clues. (Index D) When the students finish working on the task, they share their answers with the class. 	Reading and writing.
5 minutes	<p>Reflecting on the task: The teacher discusses with the students the importance of using the correct prepositions while giving directions and instructions.</p> <p>Outcome Assessment (Homework or follow-up): The teacher asks the students to write a telephonic conversation between two ladies. The first one is telling the other about the layout and surroundings of her new house and how has she decorated it.</p>

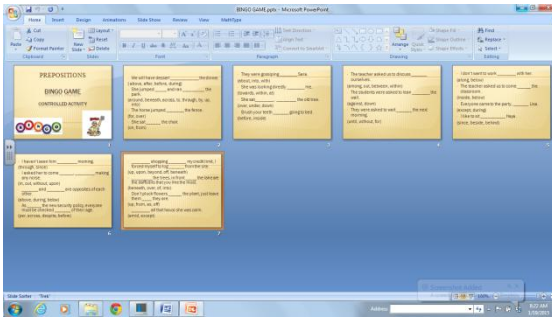

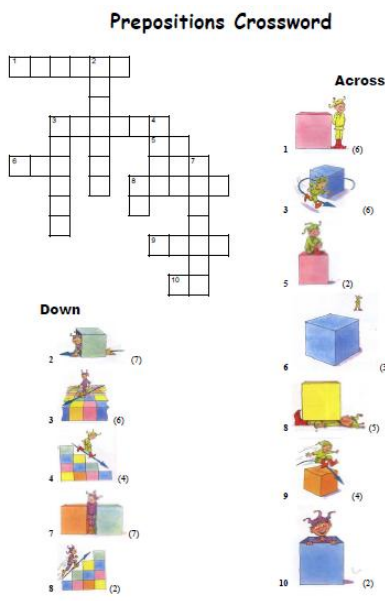
